## Program

# TOUR Terra Incognita

According to the schedule everybody will have to gather on **19<sup>th</sup> of August** in Vidin. Every participant will have a pre-booked room for one night under their own name in the 3\* Rovno hotel. 8.30 pm – welcoming drink, registration, a short briefing on the **Terra Incognita** rules and program. There is no dinner organised, however the ones that arrive earlier can visit the citadel Baba Vida and enjoy the breeze of river Danube.

### DAY 1 20<sup>TH</sup> OF AUGUST

9 am – start of the day. Visiting the national park The Belogradchik Rocks, coffee break, Montana city; lunch; Vrachanskoto zhdrelo; coffee break; finishing in Lovech city. Arriving at the 4\* Presidium hotel ([www.presidium.com](http://www.presidium.com)), free walk inside the park in the citadel of Lovech, dinner in the authentic Bulgarian pub with a traditional music. The menu includes traditional Bulgarian food, drinks and wine from the local region.

### DAY 2 21<sup>ST</sup> OF AUGUST

9 am – start of the day. Visiting the Troyan Monastery, Apriltsi city; coffee break, Sevlievo city; lunch at the Krushenski waterfalls. Visiting the Devetashka cave; arrival in Ruse city. Registering at the 3\* Riga hotel ([www.en.hotel-riga.com](http://www.en.hotel-riga.com)), visiting the Ruse city museum, time for a free walk; dinner at a fish restaurant at the bank of Danube river.

### DAY 3 22<sup>ND</sup> OF AUGUST

9 am – start of the day. Visiting the monastery in Besarbovo; coffee break; national park The Madara Rider, lunch, the 1300 years Bulgaria memorial, citadel of Pliska, coffee break; arriving in the city of Veliko Tarnovo. Registering in the 4\* Veliko Tarnovo Interhotel ([www.interhotelvt.bg](http://www.interhotelvt.bg)), group walk to the citadel of Tsarevets, dinner with a musical artistic program.

### DAY 4 23<sup>RD</sup> OF AUGUST

9 am – start of the day. Visiting Etara park, Shipka monument; coffee break, The Thracian Tomb of Kazanlak; lunch, Karlovo city, coffee break, arriving in Plovdiv. Registering in the 4\* Trimoncium hotel ([www.dedeman.com](http://www.dedeman.com)), visiting the city museum, the old town of Plovdiv, dinner.

### DAY 5 24<sup>TH</sup> OF AUGUST

9 am – start of the day. Visiting the Asenovgrad citadel, coffee break; Bachkovski Monastery; lunch; town of Koprivshtitsa; coffee break; visiting the Panagyurishte Treasure in the city museum; arriving in Sofia city, Registering at the 4\* Vega hotel ([www.hotelvegasofia.bg](http://www.hotelvegasofia.bg)), free walk around the city of Sofia, official dinner with artistic-musical dinner, handing out certificates.

### THIS IS THE END OF THE TERRA INCOGNITA TOUR FOR 2012.

- Every participant will receive a unique T-shirt, badge and a personal certificate.
- Lunches during the tour will be in restaurants and they will include soup, main dish, desert and a drink.
- There will be two coffee breaks per day.
- Dinners will be in luxurious or traditional restaurants with artistic and musical program, rich menu on a Swedish table or individual portions and it will include starter, salad, main dish and deserts, drinks and the best wines from the local regions for good mood and relaxation. There will be breakfast included for every night at the hotels.
- The tax includes medical insurance for all participants.
- The participants will be on personal expense and it is obligatory to start every morning with a full tank.
- GWCBG will organise an escort for the tour and Balkan Holidays Services will be responsible for the hotels and restaurants during the tour.
